<p>All your learning environments will look different with social distance measures in place</p> <p>We would encourage you to bring in your own laptop, so this reduces the IT equipment that is shared</p> <p>You will need to stay in your workspace allocated to you</p> <p>You must follow instructions from your tutor</p> <p>You will be in that classroom/workshop for the full day</p>	<p>You need to keep 2 metres apart where you can</p> <p>When walking in corridors keep to the left</p> <p>Look at the signs and posters which show you which stairs are up, and which are down.</p> <p>No standing and talking in the corridors</p>	<p>If you or anyone in your household has symptoms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New continuous cough and/or • High temperature above 37.8 *C and/or • loss or change to your sense of smell or taste. <p>Then you must not attend college, but you must inform us by e-mailing absent@boston.ac.uk</p> <p>If you become unwell during College times you must immediately inform a member of staff</p>	<p>You may feel more comfortable wearing a face covering whilst in corridors and communal areas when its difficult to maintain the 2 metres social distancing</p> <p>Face coverings will not be worn in teaching areas unless it is required as part of the learning activities.</p> <p>If you prefer to wear a face covering, then you will be expected to provide this and maintain it yourself.</p>
